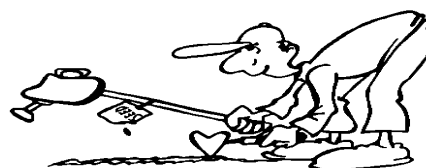

Bishop's Annual Appeal 2010 Update

Recent information from the Diocese of Trenton (6/21/2010) indicates that a total of \$36,340 has been pledged to the appeal already from St Jerome parishioners. A total of 154 donors have participated in the campaign. This represents a very impressive 17.62% participation rate, which is a very high percentage relative to other parishes of the Diocese. If you have not made a pledge yet, and would like to do so, pledge cards are available at the exits of the church. To meet our goal of \$37,000, St Jerome parish needs to pledge another \$660 to the appeal.

Dear Parishioners...

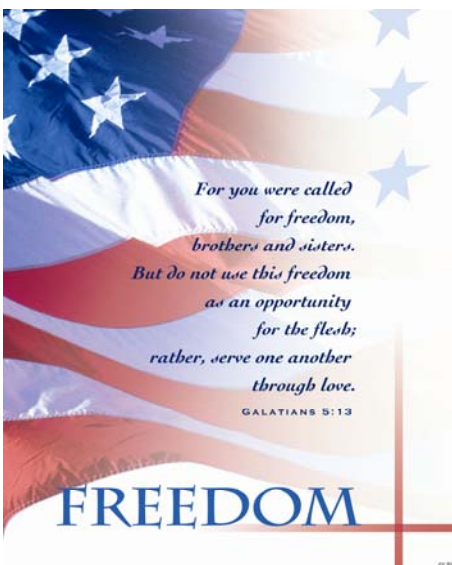
